

PEERS (Program for the Education and Enrichment of Social Skills) is a parent-assisted 14-session evidence-based social skills intervention for motivated teens who are interested in learning ways to make and keep friends. The group focuses on skills such as initiating and maintaining conversations, handling disagreements, and addressing bullying/rejection. Other targeted areas include having successful get-togethers with friends while being a good host and a good sport. During each group session, teens are taught important social and relationship-management skills, and are given the opportunity to practice these skills during socialization activities.

Who: Ages 14-17 (may be one year younger or older depending on individual)

Where: Pediatric Psychology Associates-Aventura, Weston and Coral Gables locations

When: Groups will run from October 23, 2017 – February 13, 2018 (14 sessions).

Mondays @ 7 pm in Weston; Tuesdays @ 7 pm in Aventura; Tuesdays @ 7 pm in Coral Gables

Fee: \$980 - This includes both Adolescent and Parent groups, which run simultaneously.
