



The PEERS (*Program for the Education and Enrichment of Social Skills*) Program is a parent-assisted 14-session evidence-based social skills intervention for motivated teens who are interested in learning ways to help them make and keep friends. The group focuses on skills like having conversations, handling disagreements, bullying and other forms of rejection. Other areas addressed are having appropriate get-togethers with friends, including being a good host and a good sport. During each group session, teens are taught important social skills and are given the opportunity to practice these skills during socialization activities.

Who: Ages 14-17 (may be one year younger or older depending on individual)
